Footnotes

XTRA POWER rated a short lead off the rail, was pressured midway on the final turn, widened under a drive in the upper stretch then held on well while taken in hand late. ONE SHOT (ARG) stalked the pace from the three path, gave chase beyond the seven sixteenths pole, held aim through the final turn, was no match for the winner and settled for second best. CHIEF OPERATOR, well back off the rail, bid angling widest through the final turn and finished evenly outside. FUNNY BOOK raced well back inside, bid from the seven sixteenths pole, eased three wide rounding the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. MISTER DEAN, off the pace in the four path, made a mild bid into the final turn but proved empty in the stretch. BEARIFIC rated off the pace off the rail, made a mild bid toward the three eighths pole but had little left through the turn. BRANDONS BEACH, off the pace outside, showed no response on the final turn. CHROMOSPHERE stalked the early pace inside though faded after a half mile. WRATH OF EVAN was not a factor.
