Footnotes

MOUNTAIN CLIMBER cleared the field for inside position into the opening turn, rated the pace to the head of the lane, was pressured from there and held well under steady encouragement. GHOSTS AND LEGENDS stalked the pace off the rail, bid from the three eighths pole, eased out entering the stretch, drew close late but leveled off toward the wire. DESERT FALCON settled back about the three path, made a four wide bid on the final turn then leveled off in the lane. VERY ARROGANT, off the pace three wide, bid at the three eighths pole then weakened in the stretch. DEPUTYVILLE, a step slow to break, rated off the pace outside then weakened on the final turn. IRISH MAJESTY stayed close to the early pace two deep though faded on the final turn. BAGOGA was through early while saving ground.
