TAP CHAP stalked the pacesetters outside, bid to the front in the stretch but was outfinished. BARAJA DE ORO set a clear pace off the inside then yielded at the top of the stretch. KEY TO THE EMPIRE forced the pace along the rail for half a mile then gave way.
