THIS AIN'T NO BULL vied for the lead early, dueled inside rival through the turn, lost the lead in mid-stretch then came again in a determined effort. SHOW ME THE WAY prompted the pace three wide, bid to the front in mid-stretch but was outfinished. KIWI RULER dropped well back on the turn, moved extremely wide into the lane and closed well too late. SCOUT'S HONOR angled out rallying into the stretch, came over in the final sixteenth tightening up rivals. MICHAEL'S TRIFECTA chased very wide throughout and continued well to the finish. SOKITUMI SAMURAI chased inside, steadied along in tight in the late stages. RISE AGAINST hustled up inside to duel early, weakened and steadied slightly late. BOLD THUNDER raced close up in the opening quarter then gave way. Following a stewards inquiry and an objection by the rider of SOKITUMI SAMURAI, SCOUT'S HONOR was disqualified and placed seventh for interference in the stretch.
