BEACON HALL saved ground disputing the pace, edged away late. MAPLE SONG dueled for command between foes and weakened slightly. DOMESTIC CIRCLE saved ground, had his heels clipped on the far turn. APPLIEDORE was well placed between foes and then faded. BONA FIDE (ARG) was off slow and outrun early, saved ground and passed faders. DIRT TRACK DEMON was wide and never far back, tired. BEST AFFAIR raced between foes while never far back, gave way. CAPE FINISTERRE saved ground, clipped heels and stumbled when in tight on the far turn. FRAT HOUSE vied for command three wide and tired.
