Footnotes

PRAIRIE TRIP settled off the pace outside, started a six wide drive leaving the quarter pole, dueled to the front in late yards and edged clear under the wire. TYRANA, off the pace about the four path, bid from the three eighths pole, dueled for control midstretch, picked up the winner a sixteenth further on but was outfinished in later yards. I'M YOUR GAL, well back inside, eased out at the quarter pole, had aim in late stretch and finished evenly toward the rail. CLASSY CONCERN raced off the pace in the three path, bid nearing the quarter pole and finished evenly toward mid track. MISS DUCKHORN rated a slim lead about the four path, edged clear toward the quarter pole and held the advantage to midstretch before weakening. MICHAELA'S CANDI stayed with the pace off the rail, contested while alternating for control into the turn, dropped back inside the five sixteenths pole, remained a close factor in the upper stretch though weakened with a sixteenth to go. STAR MONEY chased the pace inside, held aim in the upper stretch then weakened a furlong out. DROP THE MAIL stumbled at the start and raced wide.
