SLEWIE JONES stalked the dueling pacesetters, bid on the final turn moved clear then remained safe under confident handling. PINK SAPPHIRE chased in the two path, rallied into the stretch but was no match for the winner. HEY HEY MAMA moved easily into the far turn, clipped heels midway on the final turn and flattened out in the stretch. OH MANDIE dropped back early, moved wide on the final turn and had only a mild rally. BEHOLD A LADY chased inside, steadied briefly on the final turn and was no factor. MARIBELS GRAYGIRL prompted the pace outside for three quarters then faded. INNER JOY led inside and dueled for five furlongs then gave way. VIRTUOUSLY dropped back early and was never a factor.
