TAP TAP I WIN dueled three wide, moved to the front before the half, widened his advantage in the stretch and lasted. EZE DOES IT chased inside, angled out advancing into the stretch and closed well too late. SURE START outrun early, dropped back near the far turn then came again for the show award. LAKE FRIENDS raced close up in the two path and continued well while no threat. STORM THE FIELD vi ed between rivals and then near the inside but proved empty through the stretch. NEXT MAY broke sluggishly, chased wide and lacked a rally. ONE OF THE BEST dropped back outside early and was never a factor. WORLD RECORD forced the pace inside for five furlongs then gave way. GRANDE GAYEGO raced wide and was always outrun.
