Footnotes

SIR DANCE A LOT steadied early, raced well back from the pace through the backstretch, made up ground incrementally from the three eighths pole and was up late in a well timed ride. MIDNIGHT'S CHILD chased the pace from the inside, dueled for control midway on the turn, held the advantage to deep stretch then outfinished the final yards. DRINK AT LAST CALL, well back inside, progressed near the rail rounding the turn, angled three wide leaving the quarter pole, dueled close through the stretch but leveled off toward the wire. VAN LEROY chased the pace in mid track, came through the turn four wide then leveled off in the stretch. LOUIE'S TERRA chased the pace outside, raced seven wide on the turn and had nothing further in the lane. PRIVATE WISH was outrun in mid track. LION STRIKE hustled to a short lead off the rail, set the pace to the middle of the turn, dueled close beyond that point, faded from the eighth pole, collapsed post race and was vanned off. MISTY'S PRIDE chased the pace to the head of the lane before weakening. MANY CROWS was not a factor. SETTLE THE SCORE chased the pace from off the rail then faded through the lane.
