### Footnotes

BIG SUR angled out on the first turn, moved to the front approaching the quarter pole, led clearly, lost the advantage at the eighth pole then came again to the inside of opponents. CRUSHING awaited room on the final turn, found a seam at the head of the stretch, led a furlong out but was outfinished. BIRD'S I D raced wide throughout, loomed boldly in mid-stretch but weakened. DAN'S MY MAN prompted the pace in the two path then came up empty in the stretch. SPEEDING TRAIN saved ground off the pace and lacked a rally. ZUERSTGOLD moved clear and to the inside early, set the pace but was finished after three quarters.
