MAGICAL FEELING rated off the pace two deep, bid angling five wide at the quarter pole, dueled to the front midstretch and drew away the final sixteenth. SHE'SMYLITTLEMAN settled close outside, dueled to a brief lead in the upper stretch, was promptly caught and yielded the final sixteenth. SERIOUSLY rated off the pace inside, was pressured in mid turn, eased four wide at the quarter pole and finished evenly in third. BRIGHT ABYSS settled back from the early pace inside and bid mildly through the lane. THREETIMESAWONDER rated a short lead inside, came under pressure into the turn, maintained the advantage to the quarter pole then dueled close to midstretch before giving way. BRILLIANT SUNSHINE stalked the pace two deep, pressured the leader through the turn then weakened into the stretch.
