Footnotes

HIHOPESMPTYPOCKETS vied for command between, fell back a bit on the turn, moved out wider, closed and took the lead inside the sixteenth pole. POLLARD'S BOY vied for command very wide, edged clear mid stretch but couldn't last. PRYCE'S POSSE'S rider waved his whip repeatedly at the loose horse on the backstretch in an attempt to keep that rival from making contact, swung wide on the turn and closed well. NOFINANCINGNEEDED, off the rail and just off pace, angled wider into stretch, challenged but then weakened. HAPPY MY WAY vied for command well off rail, his rider lost her whip leaving the quarter pole. ARROGANT OFFICER was bumped and then took up when RED DOCTOBER'S rider tried to regain his balance, was bumped soundly by RED DOCTOBER again soon after, raced wide and faded. BURNING MANDATE saved ground, stopped and eased. RED DOCTOBER broke to the right and bumped ARROGANT OFFICER, his rider lost his balance and grabbed RED DOCTOBER in an attempt to soften his eventual fall.
