### Footnotes

TESSA B set the pace off the rail, drew out driving. RABIOSA was outside chasing and was no match. SHOCK APPEAL broke slow and steadied soon after, saved ground and failed to menace. WAVE OF ENERGY raced very wide and failed to menace. PRETTY ACCOLADE was also wide and no factor. LOCK THE DOOR showed little. INNER JOY, wide, failed to menace. SINATRA'SLASTDARE raced between foes and just off the pace, tired. STROUD POINT broke through the gate prior to the start, showed little. KEEP THE TICKET unseated her rider and ran off about a quarter mile prestart, saved ground and tired. GO MARCHING IN showed nothing. BABY BLUE, three wide, tired badly. NUMEROUS PROBLEMS LOADING THIS FIELD CAUSED A SIX MINUTE DELAY IN POST TIME.
