I'M SURE dropped back early, made a strong four wide bid at the far turn, caught the leaders and was up after a long drive. THREE PIECE BAND stalked the leaders outside, was engaged by the winner at the top of the stretch and battled gamely to the finish. GREEN BLUFF was in a bit tight near the far turn, angled out on the final turn then rallied mildly. CLARE CASTLE was eased back early, raced far back then closed well. VICTORY LANE saved ground just off the pace and lacked a rally. HEROIC INDEED held a narrow lead inside early, extended his margin then faded in the stretch. SPANISH COUNTRY moved closer on the final turn but had no further response. T MAN ROCKS prompted the pace outside for five furlongs then weakened. KIWI HUMOR drifted out very wide on the first turn then trailed thereafter.
