DAVERON (GER) tucked in early saving ground into the first turn, settled just off the pace, split rivals rallying into the lane then quickly drew away under confident handling. GITCHEE GOOMIE trailed when allowed to settle early, swung wide rallying into the stretch and closed strongly while no threat to the winner. CHECK THE LABEL refused to load delaying the start four minutes, rated between foes, closed well but was outfinished. DESERT SAGE (GB) raced rank early under a strong rating hold, bid into the stretch, continued well but was edged for the show award. TRIX IN THE CITY set a measured pace to the top of the stretch then gradually weakened. STRIKE THE BELL saved ground off the pace and lacked a solid rally. BET ON THE BLUE stalked close up outside for three quarters then came up empty in the stretch. EXQUISITE (NZ) was fanned four wide on the first turn, remained wide and gave way.
