IRON WILLED stalked the pace in hand, bid to the front when ready at the quarter pole and edged away in a mild drive. DEPOSIT ON ROOM angled inside on the turn, closed well and split rivals late for the place. AGAIN AGAIN AGAIN set a clear pace inside then gave way grudgingly. SECOND AND TEN chased outside, bid into the stretch then flattened out. TULLEY saved ground off the pace and never menaced. MASSIFAMI raced outside and was never a factor. DANCING QUALITYS raced within striking range in the two path and gave way. MR. MONTANA broke a step slowly, advanced five wide and stopped.
