RUN CHARLIE RUN forced the pace outside, took over into the stretch and pulled away. CLUCK FOR BUCKS chased three wide and continued well to get up for the place. SHOCK ME KAZ ducked in early, set a pressured pace then proved empty in the stretch. FROZEN FOUR angled inside in the opening quarter, raced close up then began fading on the turn. LAFTER EVER AFTER was outrun early and never menaced. SANDY PRINCE was bothered by outside rival after the start and always outrun. D T ROCKET was bothered briefly early and raced far behind. O K PANCHO was bothered early and stopped abruptly.
