Footnotes

OVER SERVED chased the pace from the outside, took aim three wide into the turn, dueled clear midstretch and steadily encouraged to widen. GRACEFUL WINDS chased the early pace toward mid track, made a bid widest on the turn, entered the lane about the four path and finished well in the late duel for place. GETTHELASTWORDIN set a pressured pace from the three path, moved clear into the turn, was caught at the five sixteenths pole, continued a close factor in the upper stretch, yielded to the winner a furlong away then outfinished in the duel for place. PICO MON pressured the pace two deep, eased out entering the stretch and finished evenly widest. REGARDING OPAL was in close pursuit inside through the backstretch then faded near the rail rounding the turn. SKY DUBAI showed no speed and never factored.
