CUVEE MADAME saved ground throughout, dueled through the turn then pulled away down the lane under steady handling. RENAISSANCE GIRL raced just off the pace in the two path and closed well while no match for the winner. EASY VIRTUE dropped far behind then offered some late energy. BOSS'S RULES dropped back early outside, moved five wide on the turn and never menaced. UNO TOUCH dueled between rivals to the stretch then weakened. SPLENDORED THING was close up four wide early then stopped. QUIET INFERNO led three wide in the opening quarter but was finished after half a mile. RULE THE DAY chased near the inside and retreated.
