Footnotes

PUNTA SAL outrun while wide for five furlongs, advanced very wide on the turn, wore down the pacesetter and was up late. DEAD MONEY chased near the inside and continued well to the finish. VICTORY CAT held a narrow lead early, pulled clear on the turn, held a big lead in the stretch but tired badly in the final furlong. OLD BUD was outrun early near the inside then showed some late energy. FORTY PRAYERS broke slowly, moved up near the inside and rallied mildly. FAIRNESS FOR ALL was outrun while wide and never a factor. RUN RICHIE RUN close up wide early under a rating hold then gave way through the stretch. MAJOR MINOR dropped back early and was always outrun. STONES THROW raced within striking range for half a mile then faded. GRAND TERROR chased between rivals and gave way readily.
