BIG RON WEST hustled to the front, repulsed a challenge near the far turn, moved clear into the stretch and lasted to finish in a dead heat. BREAK THE GLASS moved up in the two path, bid into the stretch, made a gradual gain and finished on even terms with Big Ron West. KING CRAB saved ground off the pace early, angled out advancing on the final turn and closed well. WHEREISJOHNSHOUSE dropped far back and showed some late energy. ELUSIVE SKY was close up near the inside then began retreating on the final turn. TRIBUTE broke in a complete tangle, moved swiftly wide to contention then gave way on the final turn. MERCURIO was three wide while forcing early issue then stopped abruptly. RAGING MONSTER was unruly in the post parade necessitating a late scratch and caused a seven minute delay in the post time.
