CANTONA reserved outside, bid four wide near the quarter pole and was just up under strong handling after a long drive. STAND PROUD well placed outside the dueling pacesetters, led into the stretch and continued gamely to the finish. PUNSTER alternated for the lead outside, moved to the front on the final turn but weakened in the final furlong. SPEEDING TRAIN close up outside early, dropped back on the final turn and lacked a rally. REFLECTED WAY saved ground, moved to contention into the far turn then faltered. SAN CRISTO dueled off the inside for five furlongs then stopped.
