PERENNIAL SONG chased the pace from the inside, eased out at the quarter pole, dueled to the front midstretch and drew clear nearing the sixteenth pole. LADY'S TALE drew clear to save ground approaching the turn while rating the pace, was pressured into the lane, yielded control in midstretch then just held on for place. LASAMANAMAMA chased the pace off the rail and finished well, just missing place. TERRALBA, a step slow to break, chased the leaders through the backstretch, came through the turn about the four path then leveled off the final furlong. BENIMARI, in close early chase off the rail, appeared to stride awkwardly in the vicinity of the half mile pole but raced evenly through the stretch. LEAH JET chased the pace from the inside then weakened through the lane. HLAO ROO chased the early pace from the inside then faded off the rail rounding the turn. BLISSFUL TUNE chased the pace from the inside then tired through the lane. PRECOCIOUS COMMAND showed no speed outside.
