Footnotes

EXTREME DREAM set the pace in hand, extended his lead in the stretch, came out twice under a left handed whip in the final furlong bothering DEACON FURR and just lasted. DEACON FURR reserved early, raced between rivals, advanced into the stretch, was bumped about twice by the first finisher and just missed. AZULYEKIT saved ground throughout, bid on the final turn then went evenly late. THUNDER OF INDIA angled wide into the first turn, moved closer before the half then faded. MANHATTAN BREEZE saved ground and weakened. HARBOR RIDGE prompted the pace to the final turn then gave way. ZUERSTGOLD chased close up three wide then was finished after three quarters. Following a steward's inquiry and an objection by the second finisher against the winner for interference in the stretch, EXTREME DREAM was disqualified and placed second.
