TIME FOR SPRING bumped leaving the gate, taken in hand and steered to the outside, drifted in entering the lane, closed and was just up. MOLTEN STEEL vied for command outside, was clear mid stretch and then just failed. SIR NEWCASTLE dueled between foes and then was left with the rail and weakened. AVERYON, bumped soundly leaving the gate, raced just off the rail, eased out a bit entering the stretch but failed to menace. THREE DOLLAR BILL came in after the start bumping foes, raced between foes and tired. TRUST ISSUES, well placed between foes, tired. AWESOME WIZZARD, two wide and just off the pace, tired.
