Footnotes

PULL came away sharply to rate with the pace toward mid track down the backstretch, pressured the runner-up nearing the quarter pole and dug in determinedly to get up the final yards. BIG TREE FALL HARD rated a slim lead about the three path down the backstretch, was pressured nearing the quarter pole and maintained a slight advantage to deep stretch before reluctantly ceding. STEINBRENNER chased the pace from the outside, saved ground on the turn and bid mildly for show. ROCK N HEART showed no early speed inside and bid mildly while angling outward on the turn. DEPOSIT ON ROOM chased the pace from the inside then faded on the turn. KING RAFFIE raced evenly and never factored. HANDSOME GUY, in close early chase off the rail, drifted outward on the turn and gave way from the quarter pole. DOUBLE FLIP chased the pace inside then faded on the turn. WEEKEND SECRET, a step slow to start, quickly lost contact with the field and was not encouraged late.
