VALUABLE GEM stalked the early pace from the inside, picked up the chase past the half mile pole, eased out rounding the turn, dueled the front midstretch and drew off the final sixteenths. FIVESIXSEVEN showed no early speed inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, angled out nearing the quarter and closed steadily outside for a clear place. DOCTOR DINERO had an early lead inside the opening quarter, stalked the pace to the three eighths pole, contested the turn two deep, dueled with a slight advantage in the upper stretch, relinquished control a furlong away and weakened the final sixteenth. HE HAS PASSION moved to a slim lead past the nine sixteenths pole to rate the pace, contested the turn and remained close to midstretch before giving way. D. CHRISTOPHER was outrun in an even effort. REYNARD was not a factor. SUNSHINE SAL stalked the pace about the four path, gave chase past the half pole then faded on the turn. BRIGHT N FAST was not a factor.
