DISCO DEVIN very wide throughout, advanced on the turn and was up in the final yards. HALF BLOOD PRINCE quickly sprinted clear, extended his lead in the stretch but tired late. GUSTO DI LIMONE outrun early, moved inside the winner on the turn and closed well. RISQUE MATTERS pursued the loose pacesetter and continued gamely to the finish. BELLE'S BIG BOY dropped back early, moved inside on the turn and had only a mild rally. ICE THEATER saved ground just off the pace and gave way. JUDICIOUS CAT chased close up to the turn then stopped. NOON TIME SHOTS stopped abruptly and was being eased in the final sixteenth.
