HILL CROSSING vied early inside, easily moved clear when ready on the turn then remained safe under confident handling. DEERSLAYER prompted the pace three wide, was no match for the winner but continued well for the place. CONCERTO'S THUNDER forced the pace between rivals and then inside and faltered. MASALA chased five wide, moved closer on the turn then flattened out. CHEROKEE RAIDER advanced in the two path near the far turn but had no further response. EVEN FRISKY raced within striking range three wide then gave way. STRIKING POWER dropped far behind and was always outrun. MUSCADINE broke slowly, moved inside and faded.
