DE LA WARR stalked the pacesetter outside, edged to the front in mid-stretch and prevailed driving. PARTY AT ED'S set the pace off the inside, resisted when challenged then yielded. ACT OF VALOR chased four wide, moved closer on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. RUM DIARY moved close up near the inside then lacked a stretch rally. BON CIEL prompted the pace near the inside and gradually faltered. KASH KOW KAZ dropped back early and was always outrun. TWITTER MACHINE was never a factor. HANDY raced outside and was always far behind. PEANUT HALLIDAY was always outrun. QUEENS BEST broke very slowly and showed nothing. BAILEYS HEAT was within striking range early then gave way readily. TROYSTONE hit the side of the gate at the start, stumbled and lost his rider.
