GIRL WANDO stalked the pace outside, bid to the front near the top of the stretch and edged away. KEIRALICIOUS trailed early then closed well outside to get up for the place. NANNA THE NANNY outrun early, swung very wide into the stretch and rallied. BRUSH CREEK HONEY set a clear pace along the inside to the stretch then weakened. SHELTOWEE TRACE saved ground throughout and flattened out in the stretch. LEXSHIGHSTRANK chased outside and gradually faltered. SPRINKLE broke awkwardly from the inside, chased along the rail and gave way. CAREFREE WONDER was always outrun. JAIMIEGUESTOOFORD chased wide and stopped.
