Footnotes

FLASHY EYED PEARL chased between rivals and then inside, angled out into the stretch, rallied and was up in the final sixteenth. BLACK LAGOON advanced wide on the turn, drifted in near the top of the stretch, moved clear but was outfinished. NO MORE BUBBLES chased inside, steadied twice on the turn, angled out and closed well. DANICA IRL dropped back into the far turn, angled out and continued well. RAMROD KEY broke alertly, pursued the loose pacesetter, steadied near the top of the stretch and yielded. TRUE JOANIE TRUE sprinted clear just off the inside and stopped abruptly in the stretch. Following an objection by the rider of RAMROD KEY, BLACK LAGOON was disqualified and placed fifth for interference in the stretch. An objection by the rider of NO MORE BUBBLES against the winner for interference on the turn was dismissed by the stewards.
