OUR ROCKET MON was fanned five wide on the first turn, moved closer three wide before the half, took over when ready on the final turn and quickly drew away. DANCING QUALITYS saved ground off the pace, rallied mildly and was up for the place in the late stages. BELLE'S BIG BOY chased close up in the three path, bid on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. QUALITY KING hustled to the front inside, faded on the final turn then came again to earn fourth award. MERCURIO chased outside then began weakening on the final turn. VERVEITUP forced the pace outside, led briefly inside then stopped. STRIKING HAT raced far back throughout. RAMPAIGE dropped back early three wide and gave way readily.
