HALIE'S WILD forced the pace between rivals then proved empty in the stretch. MY BLUE RIBBON lagged far behind then passed fading rivals inside down the stretch. BRIEF HOLIDAY raced just off the pace, bid outside at the quarter pole then gave way. DANGEROUS BEHAVIOR dropped back early outside and lacked a rally.
