BROOKLYN PROUD advanced in the two path into the far turn, took over midway on the turn and edged away. RULING POWER chased four wide down the backstretch and continued well to the finish. PAT RON POTOMAC chased extremely wide throughout and flattened out in the stretch. COMPELLING STAR pursued the loose pacesetter, clipped heels and bobbed at the quarter pole and lacked a further response. SECOND AND TEN quickly sprinted clear for half a mile then gave way. BROOKLAWN DOUBLE dropped back after the start then passed fading rivals. SILVER COATED saved ground and was always outrun. NOBLE'S HONOR chased close up inside to the turn then stopped. A claim of foul by the rider of COMPELLING STAR against the second finisher for interference at the quarter pole was dismissed by the stewards.
