ODOM raced wide in second flight, rallied to the lead in deep stretch and after taking the lead, edged away. WINNING DEAL vied for command between foes and then weakened late. QUITE A LEGACY was three wide in top flight, weakened. NOTABLE PLAYER was between rivals early, fell back, swung out and was too late. AFLEET AHEAD raced just off the rail, bid and then faded. WESTERN ICE saved ground dueling for command and tired.
