WATER TOWER, wide and just off pace, took over on the final turn, regained lead near eighth pole and drew off. PRINTER'S ALLEY moved off rail on the final turn, was steadied lacking room soon after, drifted out entering the lane and was up in the final stride for place. RETIRED, well off the rail and just off pace, took the lead entering stretch, was unable to match strides with winner through deep stretch and while visibly tiring, he was eased up in the final strides and was nailed for 2nd. ZINSPECTOR came in leaving the gate, dueled two wide, was carried out while tiring. IT'Z A SHARP WIND, outside and well placed, tired. BOB GRECO, wide, tired. GOTTTCHA MY DEAR, bumped around leaving the gate, raced wide and was no factor. PEP IN YOUR STEP came out leaving the gate, set the early pace inside and tired.
