### Footnotes

L. A. GIRL set a measured pace off the inside then extended her advantage through the stretch while kept to a drive. MOONLIT RIVER very wide throughout, rallied into the lane but was no match for the winner. SERENE QUEEN bore out into the first turn, prompted the pace outside then proved empty in the stretch. SARASOTA EMPRESS wide early, angled to the two path before the half then weakened. MISS TALLAHASSEE dropped back in the two path, moved wider into the stretch and lacked a rally. POWER BID saved ground while outrun to the final turn, moved wide but was no factor.
