PHIL DANCER was reserved early, rallied widest on the turn and into stretch, closed strongly and was along in time. LUCKYS DREAM vied between foes, shook loose to be clear mid stretch but couldn't last. DO IT FOR DON raced outside, bid on the turn but then flattened out. KING HENRY saved ground prompting the pace and weakened. MOONSTRUCK COWBOY had only brief speed. ONE OCEAN DRIVE raced outside and just off the pace, tired. HIHOPESMPTYOCKETS, who needed a shoe replaced in the paddock, raced off the rail, was no factor, was sore after the wire and was vanned off. LATIGO SHORE, just off the rail, failed to menace.
