DEPORTISTA was wide under rating, drifted wider entering the stretch,, took the lead and drew off driving. NILE RUNNER racing wide, passed faders for place. MERCURIO was outside and just off pace, drifted in and tired. HAYDENS HERO came out after the start, set the pace well off rail and tired. MR. HAYWOOD was well placed between foes and tired. QUALITY KING showed little. STEREO IN MOTION failed to menace. RAMPAIGE saved ground and tired badly. THERE WAS ANOTHER TWO MINUTE DELAY IN POST TIME.
