SAPHIRE SANDY vied between rivals and then inside and edged away through the stretch under steady handling. ENGLISH MANOR dueled three wide early, battled in the two path on the turn and weakened. REAL REAL SOON was outrun early then finished well in the final furlong too late. ETTELSON broke sluggishly and dropped far back but showed some late energy. GOODS IS CRACKIN chased inside early, angled out on the turn and proved empty in the stretch. CASSIDY'S KID raced outside and was always outrun. TREE MON broke slowly and was never a factor. YANKEE MICKEY broke sluggishly, rushed up inside, dueled to midway on the turn then stopped.
