Footnotes

STORMOFTHECENTURY saved ground while well placed, eased off the rail in early stretch, split foes deep stretch and got the nod. TIGHTEND TOUCHDOWN set the pace just off the rail, shook loose to be clear mid stretch and just failed. BEN'S CAT was well placed off the rail, closed with good energy. A P ELVIS raced wide and rallied too late. EL SEVENTYSEVEN, racing between foes, was left with the rail and came up empty. STRONG IMPACT broke slowly and was far back early, rallied inside. NORTHERN HAMMER broke slowly, raced very wide failed to menace. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE failed to menace. CONSOLE saved ground and showed little. VARSITY, out from the rail and just off the pace, tired. WICKED TUNE, wide in second flight, faltered badly.
