NUTMEG prompted the pace outside, edged to the front on the turn then drew away eagerly while kept to her business. DON'TSTOP THEPARTY settled behind the pacesetters, advanced five wide on the turn, continued well but was no match for the winner. WILL DO dropped back while showing poor action early then closed well inside. VICTORIANVANQUISHER raced close up in the three path for half a mile then faded in the stretch. FIFTH AND MARKET hustled to a narrow lead inside, vied through the turn then faded. MAGICAL KID broke very slowly, raced far behind and was never a factor. FRANCESCA'S FANCY chased close up four wide and gradually weakened. SCARLET CIMARRON urged close up inside, angled out on the turn and gave way.
