Footnotes

TAKKEDA stalked the pace, moved inside after the half, took over at the top of the stretch and remained clear driving. BALTIMORE BIANCA dropped back early, advanced in the two path on the final turn then flattened out. IRISHDANCEDFORFREE taken up just after the start, saved ground throughout and rallied well. SCHILADY set a pressured pace, drifted out near the quarter pole and weakened. BLAZING ARCHES chased very wide and lacked a rally. QUIET LIVEING forced the pace outside to midway on the final turn then gave way. PROUD QUEEN chased within striking range wide and stopped. ELVI'S ELPIDA broke slowly then began retreating after a quarter mile.
