J MAN allowed to settle, advanced three wide on the turn, collared the pacesetter into the stretch and edged clear in the final furlong. STREET BALLAD ducked in the start, rushed to the front inside after the quarter then weakened. UNDISCOVERED earned a narrow advantage in the three path, vied through the turn and faded. STORMIN CITY well placed outside between rivals, proved empty in the stretch. GLADIATORS SHOT dropped back inside early and lacked a rally. MI DRAGON forced the pace off the inside for three furlongs then gave way. CAROLINA CHANT showed poor action early, advanced very wide down the backstretch then stopped.
