### Footnotes

NORMAL PRACTICE quickly moved clear inside, repulsed a challenge on the turn then drew off under a mild drive in the final furlong. TROUBLE IN DODGE chased five wide early, advanced strongly on the turn to near even terms then tired in the final eighth. TIZ RELEVANT chased wide early in the second flight, made a brief bid on the turn and was easily third best. PEARL JAMMER was close up early between rivals, drifted very wide into the stretch and was no factor. RYEGRASS ROAD moved up inside in the opening quarter then gradually retreated. MAYA CODE raced between rivals in the two path early and gave way. MAGIC CHANCE broke slowly and trailed throughout.
