WILBURN angled four wide into the first turn, remained wide, bid on the final turn, edged to the front at the quarter pole and prevailed in a long drive. REDEEMED allowed to settle in the two path, moved strongly five wide on the final turn, rallied outside and was just up for the place. I'M STEPPIN' IT UP prompted the pace in the two path, earned a brief lead on the final turn and held on very gamely to the finish. TURBO COMPRESSOR was in a bit tight on the first turn, advanced near the inside then flattened out in the stretch. SCOTUS dropped back early and rallied mildly while no factor. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN was in tight between foes into the first turn and was finished midway on the final turn. CONCEALED IDENTITY trailed to the stretch, moved out and lacked a rally. JOE VANN set a pressured pace inside and was finished by midway on the final turn.
