ORBISTON PARVA advanced between foes, took the lead near furlong marker and drew clear. DOBRA set the pace well off the rail, was no match late. PYRAMYST saved ground, split foes moving but then flattened out'. SHILOH'S VINE was well placed between foes, faded. ADELICATE MISS raced wide while just off the pace and then tired. ALL BETS OFF failed to menace. JUDIANE'S JUBILEE ducked in leaving the gate. MS. N. TARSIA saved ground just off pace, rider's saddled slipped on the final turn and she was being eased through the stretch.
