OFFICER ALEX dueled to the stretch then extended his advantage impressively to the finish. TIME FOR SPRING bobbled after the start, chased wide and closed well. TRUST ISSUES raced close up three wide and weakened in the stretch. RITTENHOUSE SQUARE raced within striking range and lacked a rally. KIWI STORM vied for the lead off the inside to the stretch then gave way. SAILOR'S REVENGE broke sluggishly and was always outrun. KEEPMEINSTITCHES moved inside on the turn and faltered. FRANK AND DINO saved ground and gave way readily. GLANCING BLOW was always outrun.
