SLOANE RANGER settled four wide just off the pace, bid on the turn, surged in the final sixteenth and was just up. ROD'S FIVE STAR dropped back in the opening quarter, bid in the two path on the turn, led late but was caught in the final strides. PHIL DANCER rushed up nearest the inside to press the pace, dropped back briefly on the turn then came again through the stretch but was outfinished. MANAGED ACCOUNT dropped well behind then showed some late energy. BLUE NOTION vied for the advantage three wide then weakened in the final furlong. GOLDEN SUCCESS forced the pace four wide then gradually weakened.
